Château de Versailles

The crowning glory of the Sun King. The royal suites, the Hall of Mirrors, the gardens and groves each are great treasures to discover. *Versailles* [B2]

- i Admission** > the royal suites are open daily except on Mondays and on certain bank holidays. From the 1st April to the 31st October between 9.00 am and 6.30 pm and from the 1st November to the 31st March between 9.00 am and 5.30 pm.

Château de Fontainebleau

Château de Vincennes

Formerly a royal residence between the 12th and 18th centuries, the château's enceinte, keep and holy chapel have seen French history unfold and are remarkably well preserved. *Vincennes* [C1-2]

Château de Blandy-les-Tours

The château dates back to The Hundred Years War and is one of the last remnants of medieval architecture in the region. *Blandy les Tours* [C2]

PARIS MUSEUM PASS

The Paris Museum Pass is valid for 2, 4 or 6 consecutive days and offers free, fast-track admission to over 60 sites in Paris, including the Louvre and Orsay museums, the Pompidou Centre, Cité des Sciences et de l'Industrie science museum, the Rodin museum, and more. It also gives access to many other sites around the Ile-de-France region such as château de Fontainebleau, château de Vincennes, the Basilica of Saint Denis, the Air and Space museum, etc.



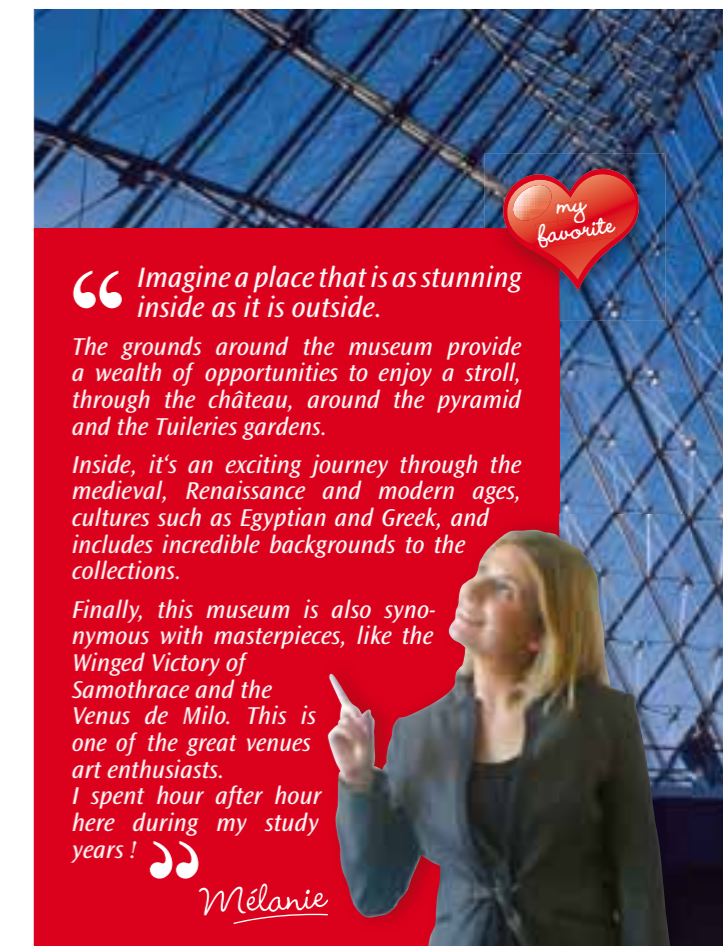

Louvre Museum

This lavish former official residence of the French kings is now home to one of the most famous museums in the world. Explore the countless treasures in the Egyptian antiquities collection, meet the enigmatic gaze of the Mona Lisa, admire the Venus de Milo, the French crown jewels, and more. *Paris*

Finally, this museum is also synonymous with masterpieces, like the Winged Victory of Samothrace and the Venus de Milo. This is one of the great venues art enthusiasts. I spent hour after hour here during my study years! ”

Orangerie Museum

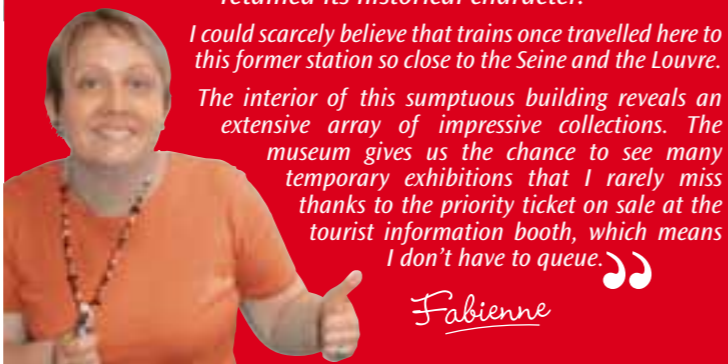
Discover or re-discover the Water Lilies just as Claude Monet intended you to see them. The renovation work that was completed in 2006 has brought the splendour of the canvasses back to the fore through the use of natural daylight. **Paris**

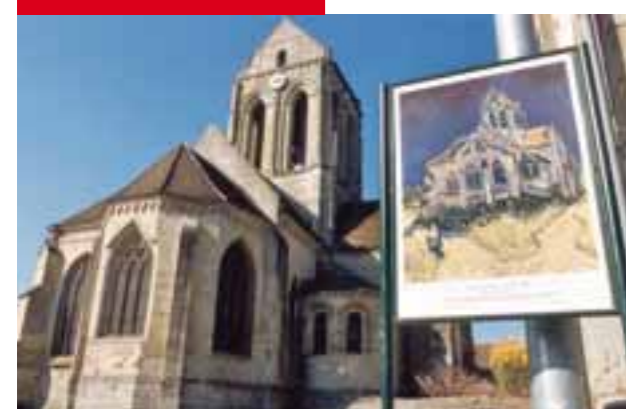
Painters in Auvers-sur-Oise

Delve into the world of 19th-century artists from Van Gogh to Pissarro, from Cézanne to Daubigny. You can't fail to be enchanted by this village and its exceptional charm. Discover the 11th-century church that overlooks Auvers-sur-Oise and which was the subject of a painting by Van Gogh that is now displayed in the Musée d'Orsay, in Paris.

Take the “Travelling with the Impressionists” demonstration tour at the Château d'Auvers-sur-Oise with presentations and displays of over 500 works throughout the visit.

Musée d'Orsay

The museum was originally built for the 1900 World Fair, and is home to many masterpieces by the Impressionists and other Great Masters (Manet, Monet, Degas, Van Gogh, Gauguin, etc). **Paris**

Roof of the Grande Arche at La Défense

The roof of the Grande Arche is an exceptional spot at the top of the Grande Arche in the La Défense district. The panoramic glass elevators, the only ones of their kind anywhere in the world, take you up 110 metres (360 ft). Up there you can discover the outstanding view that presents a large number of Paris major monuments in a line along the Axe Historique, a permanent 3D exhibition, a film looking at the different stages involved in the construction of the Arche, a model room and the “Ô110” restaurant. **Paris**

GENERAL CONDITIONS FOR RESERVATIONS

ARTICLE 95 - The separate invoicing of the various elements making up a package does not release the seller from any obligations coming under this heading.

ARTICLE 99 - The purchaser may transfer the contract to a transferee who fulfils the same conditions as the purchaser himself/herself to benefit from the journey or holiday, as long as the contract has not yet taken effect.

Notwithstanding any statement more favourable to the transferor, the transferor is bound to inform the purchaser of his decision by recorded delivery letter at least seven days before the beginning of the journey. In the case of a cruise, this period is extended to fifteen days. This transfer is in no way subject to the prior authorisation of the seller.

ARTICLE 101 - When, before the departure of the purchaser, the seller has no choice but to modify one of the key elements of the contract, such as a significant rise in prices, the purchaser, without prejudice to his/her right to compensation for any damage which may be incurred, and after being so informed by the seller by recorded delivery mail, may:

- either cancel the contract and obtain the immediate reimbursement of all sums paid without any penalty whatsoever,
- or accept the modification or the substitution journey proposed by the seller: an amendment to the contract stipulating the said modifications will then be signed by both parties. Any reduction in the price is deducted from any amounts remaining due by the purchaser, and, if the payments already made exceed the price of the modified service offered, the excess amount must be settled in his/her favour before the date of departure.

SPECIFIC BOOKING CONDITIONS

ARTICLE 4 - BOOKINGS

Bookings can be made either in writing by mail or fax or by phone. According to the number of places free, the booking is only deemed to be firm when advance payment amounting has been settled and a copy of the booking contract signed by the client has been sent back to Espace du Tourisme before the date stipulated on the contract.

ARTICLE 5 - PAYMENT OF THE BALANCE

The client must pay the booking department the balance of the services agreed to and remaining owing at least one month prior to the beginning of the holiday notwithstanding article 98, paragraph 10. Any client who

does not settle the balance by the agreed date is considered as having cancelled the booking. This booking is once more open to purchase and no reimbursement shall be made.

ARTICLE 6 - LATE BOOKINGS

In the case where the booking takes place less than 30 days before the beginning of the stay, the payment of the total amount of the stay price is required.

ARTICLE 7 - VOUCHERS

Upon receipt of the balance, Espace du Tourisme will send the client the vouchers to be given to the various agents providing a service during the stay, or acknowledgement ARTICLE 8 - ARRIVAL

The client must arrive on the day and at the time mentioned on the contract or the voucher. In the case of a late or delayed arrival, or should the client be unable to leave at the last minute, the client must inform the agent whose address and telephone number appear on the voucher. Any services not enjoyed due to this lateness must be paid for and can in no way lead to reimbursement of any kind.

ARTICLE 9 - CANCELLATION BY THE CLIENT

Any cancellation must be notified by recorded delivery letter or telegram to Espace du Tourisme. The cancellation of the stay by the client implies that the client shall not be reimbursed for a certain amount which varies according to the type and date of the stay, plus the administrative and insurance costs. Unless otherwise stipulated, the following is valid:

- Cancellation occurring more than 30 days before the beginning of the stay: 10 % of the total cost of the stay shall be retained.
- Cancellation occurring between the 30th and the 21st day inclusive before the beginning of the stay: 25% of the total cost of the stay shall be retained.

Claims concerning the state of the accommodation provided must be reported to Espace du tourisme within 48 hours of arrival.
